



Maintenance | **Aspire**

STEPS

Initial Maintenance

Cleaning Products	Diversy Profi, CleanVia CV1000, or CleanBreak Cleaner Disinfectant
Dilute oz/gal	10oz
Equipment	Micro-fiber mop or 3M Red Buffer Pad 5100

Regular Maintenance

Cleaning Products	Diversy Profi, CleanVia CV1000, or CleanBreak Cleaner Disinfectant
Dilute oz/gal	2-4oz
Equipment	Micro-fiber mop or 3M Red Buffer Pad 5100

Heavy Soil & Restorative Cleaning

Cleaning Products	Diversy Profi, CleanVia CV1000, or CleanBreak Cleaner Disinfectant
Dilute oz/gal	16oz
Equipment	Micro-fiber mop or 3M Red Buffer Pad 5300

NOTE

Dilution and coverage specification relate to the Clean Via CV 1000 product only. Follow manufacturer's recommendations for other products.

INITIAL MAINTENANCE

1. Remove all surface dirt and debris by vacuuming, sweeping, damp cloth or sponge mopping. Commercial grade electric floor scrubber/extractor equipment is recommended for large or high-traffic areas. If using a commercial floor cleaner, use the softest bristle attachment available with minimum pressure.
2. Scrub the area using approved cleaning solution (10oz /gal of water), micro-fiber mop (or buffer pad). Avoid flooding the flooring.
3. Pick up solution with a wet vacuum.
4. Rinse with clean water and remove with a wet vacuum or floor extractor.
5. Repeat rinsing until water removed is clean.
6. Allow to dry before use (6-8hrs).

REGULAR MAINTENANCE

1. Remove all surface dirt and debris by vacuuming, sweeping, damp cloth or sponge mopping. Commercial grade electric floor scrubber/extractor equipment is recommended for large or high-traffic areas. If using a commercial floor cleaner, use the softest bristle attachment available with minimum pressure.
2. Scrub the area using approved cleaning solutions (2-4 oz./ gal. of water), micro-fiber mop (or buffer pad). Avoid flooding the floor.
3. Pick up solution with a wet/dry vacuum (if necessary).

HEAVY SOIL & RESTORATIVE CLEANING

1. Remove all surface dirt and debris by vacuuming, sweeping, damp cloth or sponge mopping. Commercial grade electric floor scrubber/extractor equipment is recommended for large or high-traffic areas. If using a commercial floor cleaner, use the softest bristle attachment available with minimum pressure.
2. Heavy scrub the area using approved cleaning solution (16oz /gal of water). This cleaning may be performed with an auto scrubber and approved pad (3M Blue Cleaner Pad 5300).
3. Vacuum soiled solution with a wet /dry vacuum.
4. Rinse with clean water.
5. Allow floor to dry thoroughly (6-8hrs).
