EXCEED MAINTENANCE

Exceed contains a high performance urethane wear layer with aluminum oxide particles, cured by a UV process. Through this technology, Exceed offers a low-maintenance floor solution that provides superior appearance retention, easy maintenance, and a high level of resilience. Exceed upkeep does not require the use of polish or wax. Proper cleaning plays an essential role in keeping your floor attractive. The following guidelines will help extend the appearance and life of your product.

INITIAL CONSTRUCTION CLEANING

1. Wait a minimum of 24-48 hours before conducting the initial cleaning.
2. Remove all loose debris by sweeping or vacuuming.
3. Ensure that all traces of adhesive are removed from the flooring surface using a clean cloth dampened by mineral spirits.
4. Clean floor with a mop dampened by a suitable neutral detergent such as Diversy Profi. Follow container instructions and/or dilution chart to ensure proper water/detergent mixing ratio.

ROUTINE MAINTENANCE

The following recommendations are provided as a guideline, and the frequency can be changed to optimize product appearance.

1. Remove all surface dirt and debris by vacuuming, sweeping, wiping or sponge mopping.
2. Use damp mop or an automatic scrubber with a properly diluted neutral cleaner on a regular basis in order to maintain an attractive floor appearance. Commercial grade auto scrubber/extractor equipment is recommended for high traffic areas. Use the softest bristle attachment available (or red buffer pads) with a minimum amount of pressure.
3. Scrub area using approved Diversy Profi (2-4 ounces/gallon of water) and a micro-fiber mop (or buffer pad). Avoid flooding the flooring. Flooding or excess water can lead to captured moisture between seams, which may result in split seams. A misted spray should be used to project cleaning solution.
4. When necessary, dampen scrubber with a red scrubbing pad or soft nylon brush to prevent accumulation of soil.
5. Remove solution with wet vacuum if necessary.
